YOU'RE INVITED!

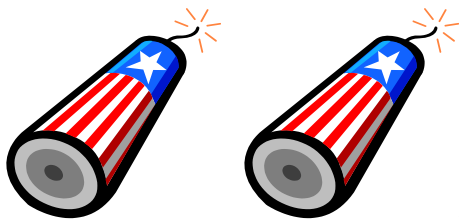
